Through six two-and-a-half-day sessions held in locations from the mountains to the coast, LNC participants gain knowledge and build networks that they can leverage personally, professionally, and for the benefit of the state and its people.

LNC works with a variety of individuals across multiple industries and the private and public sectors to develop leaders who want to drive improvements and influence outcomes. The program takes a comprehensive, integrated approach that showcases how its five focus areas are deeply intertwined. Program participants collaborate on solving real challenges, and they roll up their sleeves to volunteer in ways that enrich and support citizens across the state.

LNC is ideal for individuals who are seeking groundbreaking ideas and hands-on opportunities to make North Carolina an even better place to live. Participation in the prestigious LNC program is open to all residents of North Carolina, and LNC boasts a diverse blend of leaders in its alumni ranks. NORTH CAROLINA IS NOT ONLY HOME TO NOTABLE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND THE WORLD-RENOWNED RESEARCH TRIANGLE PARK, IT PROUDLY SUPPORTS A VARIETY OF INDUSTRIES FROM TECHNOLOGY TO AGRICULTURE TO MEDICAL CARE TO FILM MAKING.

During the economic development session, participants explore North Carolina's roots in agriculture and textiles and its emergence as a leader in entrepreneurial spirit and business innovation. Economic developers, business owners, and policy experts share how program participants can cultivate North Carolina's economic growth and success from urban to rural communities. This session is uniquely entrenched in the riches of North Carolina's past with a view towards the state's economic future. This is a rare opportunity to meet and learn from esteemed captains of industry and critical drivers of economic growth — individuals who have invested in and shaped this state.

NORTH CAROLINA HAS HAS LONG BEEN A LEADER IN EDUCATION.

The state continues to unfold and pilot new ideas to make education more accessible and meaningful for students, teachers, parents, and businesses. Class members get an insider's view of North Carolina's education system framed within local, state, and national perspectives. Teachers, administrators, and policy makers share their views and expertise around the challenges and opportunities facing education today. During the education session participants examine the full scope of education from pre-kindergarten programs to post-graduate studies. They dig deep into all facets of this complex topic by evaluating funding streams, exploring demographic trends, and assessing the impact of education on other sectors. This session provides in-depth knowledge of education reform and addresses the innovations, pitfalls, and shifts that shape the present and the future of education for all North Carolinians.

THE STATE BOASTS SCENIC VISTAS FROM MOUNTAINS TO SEASHORE AND LUSH FIELDS IN BETWEEN.

North Carolina's natural resources have been instrumental in driving economic growth and creating appeal to investors and citizens alike. In this riveting program, participants collaborate to define the broad topic of "environment" as they examine the state's natural resources, energy options, sustainability, and cutting-edge research. Through a series of behind-the-scenes tours, interactive exercises, and presentations, leaders better understand how to balance natural resources with economic growth as they explore the inextricable links among environment, technology, entrepreneurship, and economic development. The environment session challenges participants' views of the environment and uncovers emerging trends that could either protect or destroy the environment as well as practices that could jeopardize economic growth or lead to new innovation and revenue streams.

Be a more active citizen.

GOVERNMENT IS CENTRAL TO THE INDUSTRIES, BUSINESSES, SERVICES, AND PEOPLE OF NORTH CAROLINA. It is a complicated, and sometime controversial, topic that easily bewilders. The government session seeks to eliminate some of the mystery. Class members gather in Raleigh, the historic capital city, to dig into nuances of state government around the budget, the legislative process, government services, and political trends. Leaders acquire a new appreciation for the challenges, snares, and opportunities of running our state's government. Representatives from various levels of government, legislators, and key decision-makers illuminate how North Carolina's leaders can collaborate to move the state forward for the collective good. This session guides participants towards becoming more engaged citizens and helps them understand how individuals can impact decisions made by their government.

THIS EYE-OPENING, EMOTIONALLY-CHARGED SESSION HIGHLIGHTING ISSUES AROUND HEALTH CARE COSTS AND ACCESS, AS WELL AS RELATED TOPICS SUCH AS HUNGER, NUTRITION, MENTAL ILLNESS, AND AGING, WILL LEAVE A LASTING IMPRESSION ON PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS.

The health and human services session offers opportunities for participants to learn what it takes to create, support, and nurture a healthy population and understand how poor health impacts education and economic development. Presentations during this session address the inextricable links between health and economic stability for North Carolina. A compelling, very personal exercise puts class members into the shoes of economically disadvantaged North Carolinians to help them gain insight into the challenges many North Carolinians face and to appreciate the roles and responsibilities related to health and human services.

Leadership North Carolina **Leadership Lunch and Learn Series**

AS LEADERSHIP NORTH CAROLINA CONTINUES TO GROW, IT IS IMPERATIVE TO OFFER OPPORTUNITIES FOR LNC PARTICIPANTS TO CONNECT WITH PARTICIPANTS AND ALUMNI WITHIN THEIR COMMUNITIES. LNC alumni and staff have developed a volunteer driven effort to fulfill this need — the Leadership North Carolina Lunch and Learn Series. Current participants, key alumni, and LNC staff plan and host a lunch, inviting participants and alumni from surrounding counties. Each Lunch and Learn event engages two to three speakers to informally discuss a specific topic that engages local leaders in a meaningful conversation regarding issues and opportunities facing local communities.

The Red Thread Projects

THE LNC PROGRAM OPENS THE EYES OF ITS PARTICIPANTS. LNC sessions have been extremely successful in providing knowledge and strategies that encourage participants to take action and leverage their networks and resources for the benefit of the state. Participants leave each session excited about the issues discussed and passionate about having an impact. The Red Thread Project is an innovative initiative designed to channel participants' enthusiasm into concrete service opportunities.

The Red Thread Project not only engages the powerful network of LNC participants and alumni; it reaches well beyond this core group. The Red Thread Project allows participants and alumni to lead the charge by taking Red Thread Project opportunities back to their employers, employees, and personal circles to use their collective knowledge and influence to make a greater impact on the state.

Leadership North Carolina Forum

SINCE 2008, THE LEADERSHIP NORTH CAROLINA FORUM HAS BEEN A STAPLE OF LNC, SERVING AS “LNC IN ONE DAY” FOR CURRENT PARTICIPANTS, ALUMNI, AND THE COMMUNITY AT LARGE. The LNC Forum is open to business professionals, educators, nonprofit leaders, entrepreneurs, and government employees. 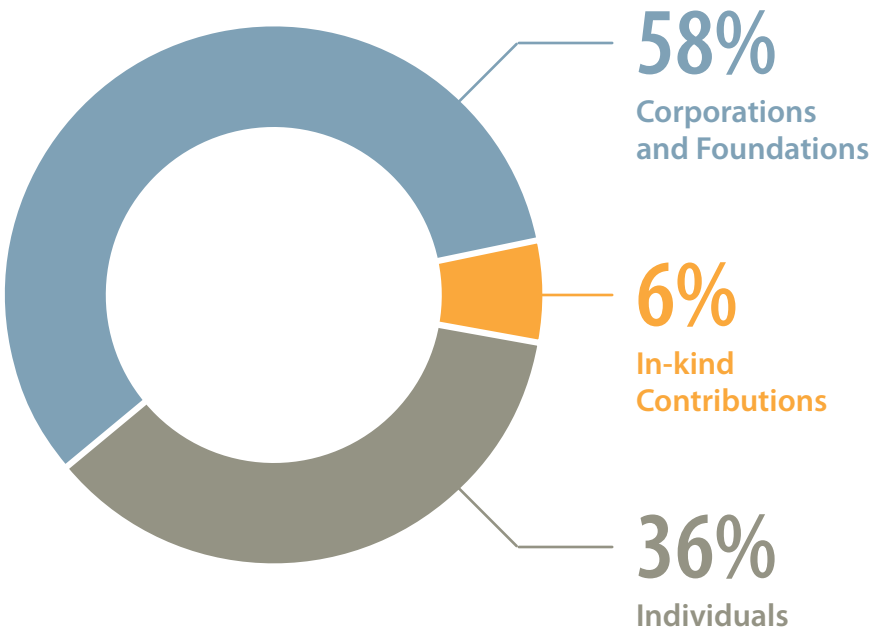
