



Leadership North Carolina Class XXVI Application Summary

The Leadership North Carolina program application for Class XXVI (2018-2019) will be available online throughout the May 16 – June 29, 2018, application window. Applicants may save their applications in-progress and return to them throughout the application period.

Biographical Information

The LNC program application requires each candidate to provide basic biographical information, including home and business contact details, education, employment history, community involvement, and leadership experience. Candidates should be prepared to upload a brief bio in paragraph form and a photograph.

Narrative Questions

1. List present and past community, civic, religious, political, social, or other activities you are involved with, in order of their importance to you.
2. Describe a significant accomplishment in one of the areas mentioned above.
3. List three leadership traits that describe you and explain how you put them into practice.
4. What do you consider to be the three biggest challenges currently facing the state and why? What are some potential solutions?
5. What one aspect of North Carolina would you most like to have an impact on and why?
6. What do you expect to gain from your participation in Leadership North Carolina?
7. Share anything else you would like the Selection Committee to know about you. This can include awards or recognition, additional examples of your engagement and leadership, or elements not captured in responses to the previous questions.

Program Protocols and Application Fee

Each applicant is required to read and accept the terms of the program protocols included in the application and submit the \$75 application fee.

Scholarship Application

Applicants who wish to be considered for a partial, need-based scholarship must complete the separate scholarship application provided that will be available under the "[Apply](#)" tab on the LNC website during the application period.

Letters of Recommendation

Each applicant must request two letters of application, to be submitted directly to LNC. The application requires names and contact information for the two references. Providing this information does not generate a request for letters. It is the applicant's responsibility to request the letters directly from his or her references and to make sure they are received by the application deadline. Letters must be submitted through the recommendation link on the "[Apply](#)" page.
