
## What is a system?

"Systems change is about shifting the conditions holding the problem in place."








## **Example Outcomes**


**North Star:** Increase entrepreneurial starts, small business growth, and overall contract and capital readiness particularly among Black, Indigenous, People of Color (BIPOC), women, and rural entrepreneurs. Tracked outcomes over time could include:


- Increased awareness and use of technical assistance resources by local entrepreneurs
- Increased entrepreneurial starts and decreased business failures
- New products developed, products licensed, and patents filed
- Increased revenue/small business across all demographics/census tracts
- Increased diversification of revenue for businesses and getting them into traded sector economies
- Increased number of employees/business across all demographics/census tracts
- Increased number of livable wage jobs w/ benefits created by region's small business economy
- Increased investment (debt, equity, and grants) to capital ready small businesses across all demographics
- Increased number of contracts for local businesses through enhanced procurement commitments



## Potential Organizational Structure for Region's Equitable Entrepreneurial Ecosystem








Catalytic investment into ecosystem increasing
