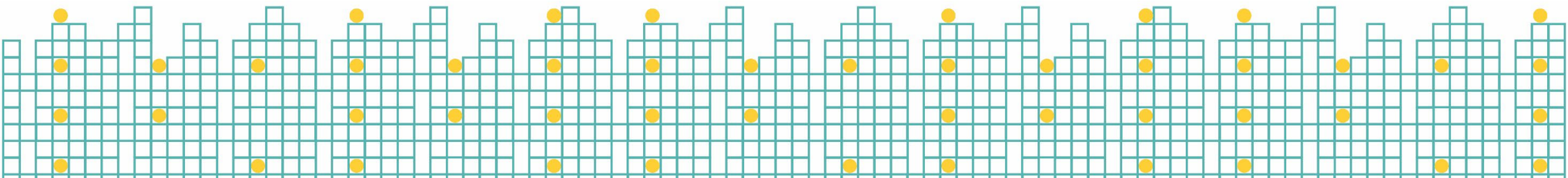

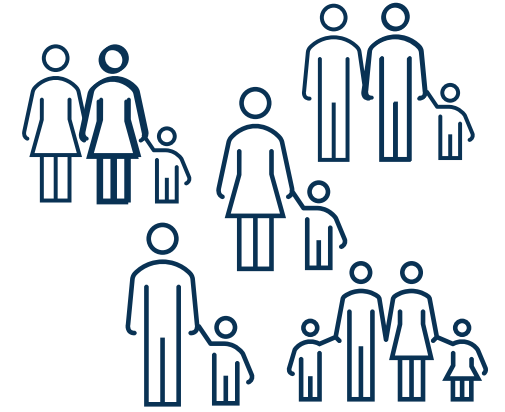

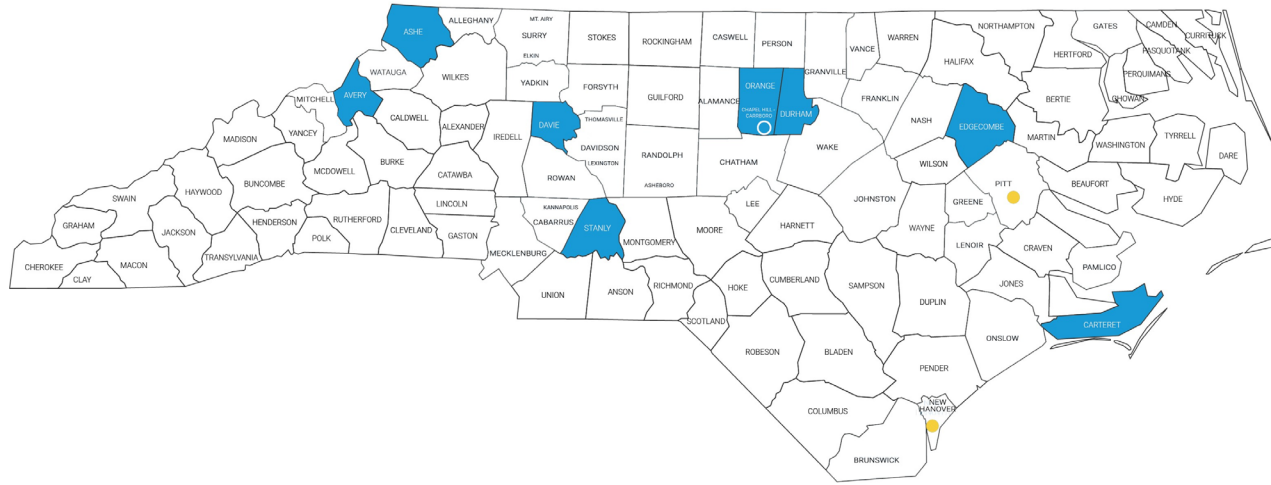


Families

■ Hill-supported 95RAP District

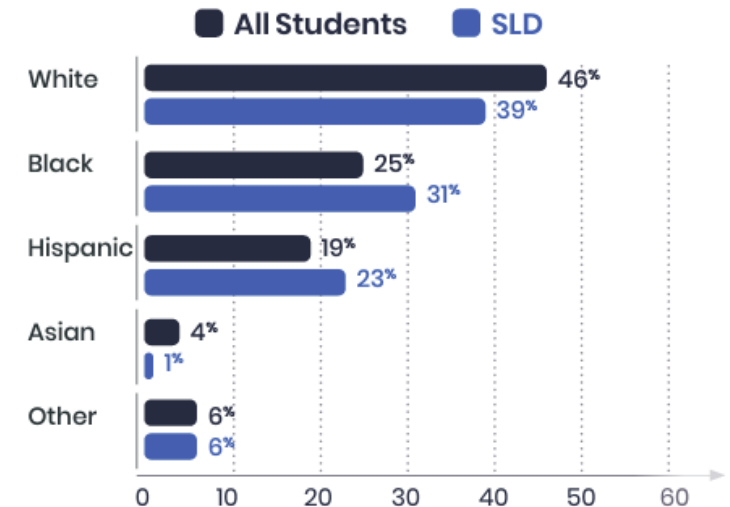

- Affiliate schools in Greenville and Wilmington
- Reading Intervention (95 RAP) partnerships in
 - 8 school districts
 - 26 public charter schools
 - 17 independent private schools
 - 2 university lab schools
- Trained teachers from every district over last 20 years

- 67,950 students with Specific Learning Disability
