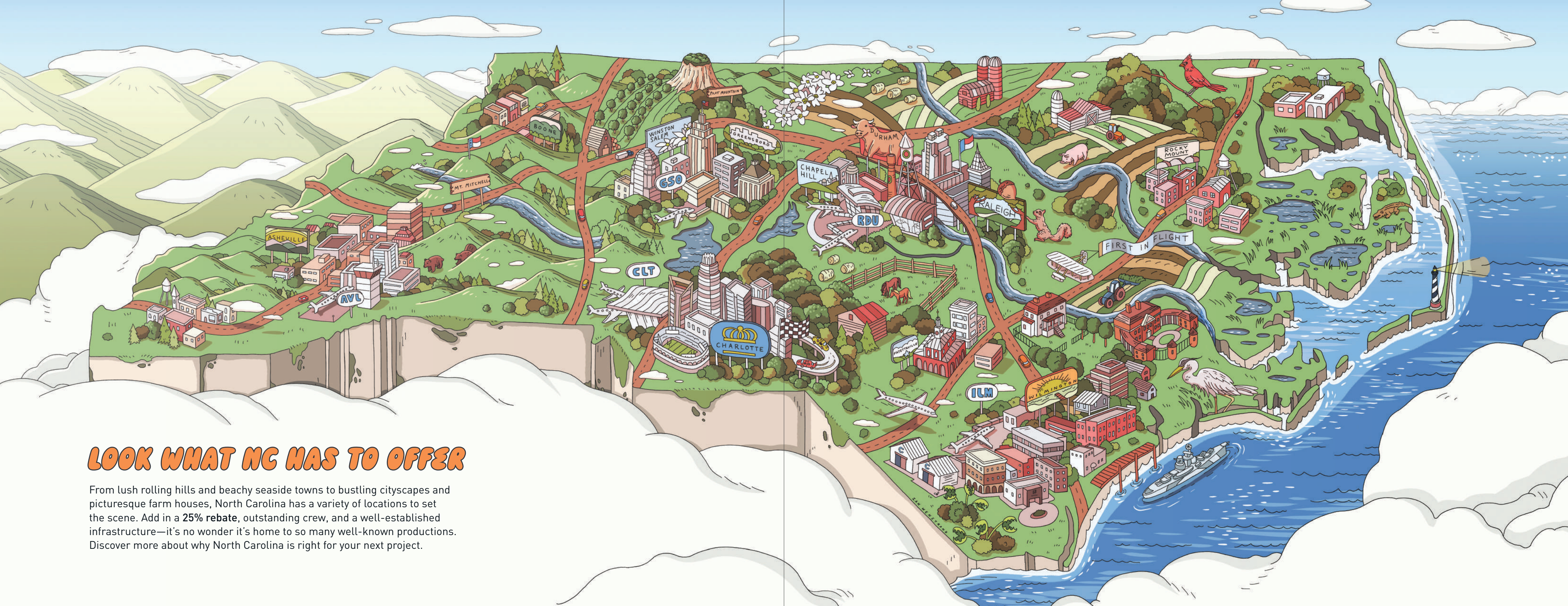

Add in a **25% rebate**, outstanding crew, and a well-established infrastructure—it's no wonder it's home to so many well-known productions. A PEEK INTO THE PERKS

North Carolina offers a generous **25% rebate** on a production's direct in-state spend. Funded through the N.C. Film & Entertainment Grant, this program has no sunset date and applicable funding for any and all projects. Even better, once ready for payout, the production is paid directly by the State. 25% REBATE INCENTIVE

Via funds from the NC Film and Entertainment Grant

APPLICATION

Complete Intent to Film Form online and then NC Film Office will send formal application. Applications are reviewed within 30 days.

MINIMUM SPEND

\$500,000 per episode average for tv and streaming series
\$1.5 million for feature-length films
\$500,000 for made-for-tv and streaming movies
\$250,000 for commercials*

PER PROJECT CAP

\$15 million per season for tv and streaming series
\$7 million for feature-length films (inc. made-for-tv and streaming movies)
\$250,000 for commercials*

ANNUAL "STARTING" ALLOCATION

\$31 million per fiscal year (NC fiscal year runs July 1-June 30)

QUALIFIED LABOR

First \$1 million of each resident and nonresident qualify

LOAN OUT WITHHOLDING

4% for out-of-state

QUALIFYING EXPENSES

Goods / Services / Compensation and Wages / Fringes / Per Diems / Living Expenses and Stipends

PROMOTION

Credits to include logo provided by NC Film Office and recognition of local film commission. Production to also work with NC Film Office on additional marketing opportunities promoting the state.

STANDARDS & PRACTICES

Projects containing "obscene" material, as defined in G.S. 14-190.1, or "harmful to minors," as defined in G.S. 14-190.13, are ineligible.

AUDIT

Audit to be performed by an independent NC-licensed CPA at cost to production.

PAYOUT

Payouts are typically made within 45 days of receiving closeout items, including at least access to picture-lock version of project.

SUNSET DATE

None

*Commercials should contact the NC Film Office before proceeding with applying for better understanding of the program.

MORE BUILT-IN BENEFITS

While the 25% rebate is a plus, it's the people and strong infrastructure that make the difference. North Carolina boasts more than 3,700* trained and experienced crew members, 1,200* support service businesses and two multistage purpose-built facilities: Cinespace Studios-Wilmington and Dark Horse Studios.

Getting to North Carolina is also easy. All four International airports have direct flights to/from the greater New York City area, and two have direct flights to/from the Los Angeles area. Once here, out-of-towners can discover award-winning dining, scenic beauty and some of the hidden gems that make North Carolina one of the nation's top 10 most visited states.

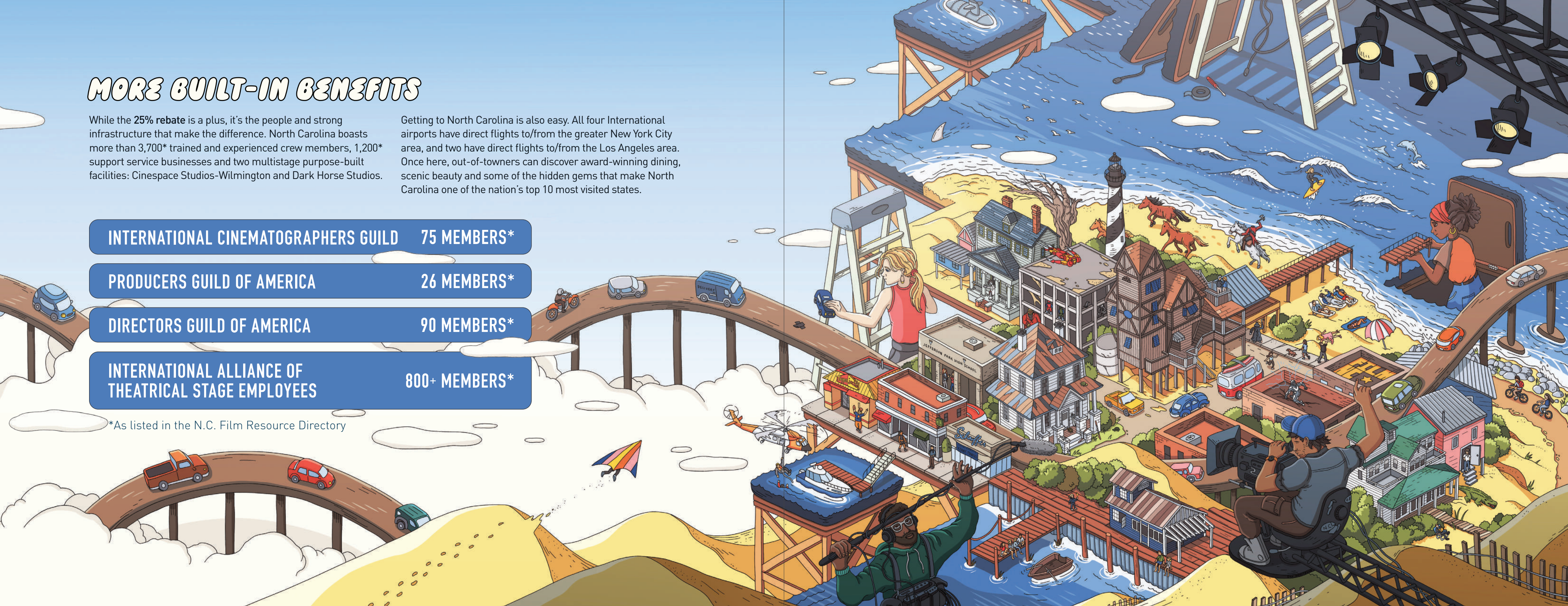
