# NC Creating success with NCMBC

- Defense prime contracts executed in NC (FY20): \$6.1B (\$1.5B increase over FY19)
- Federal prime contracts executed in NC (FY20): \$9.5B (\$2.5B increase over FY19)
- Statewide impact of contracting: federal prime contractors in 97 counties (FY20)
- PRIMARY obstacle to growing contracting: need more businesses in the federal market







# NC Creating success in our military

- Assisted businesses in winning 4,168 contracts, worth \$16B+
  - Contracts generated \$623M+ in State Corporate Income Tax alone
- Events: hosts Summits in strategic industries (medical, textiles, aerospace, federal construction/energy, subsistence, cybersecurity, and a defense trade show at Forsyth Tech Community College
- MatchForce.org: connects 200,000 unfiltered opportunities to businesses annually

**Opportunity: NCMBC partner with** N.C. Chamber/chambers statewide to get businesses in market – 23% of federal contracts are targeted at small businesses

#### **New Scholarship Funding**

FY 2021-22 amount increased from \$970,000 to \$1.7M
