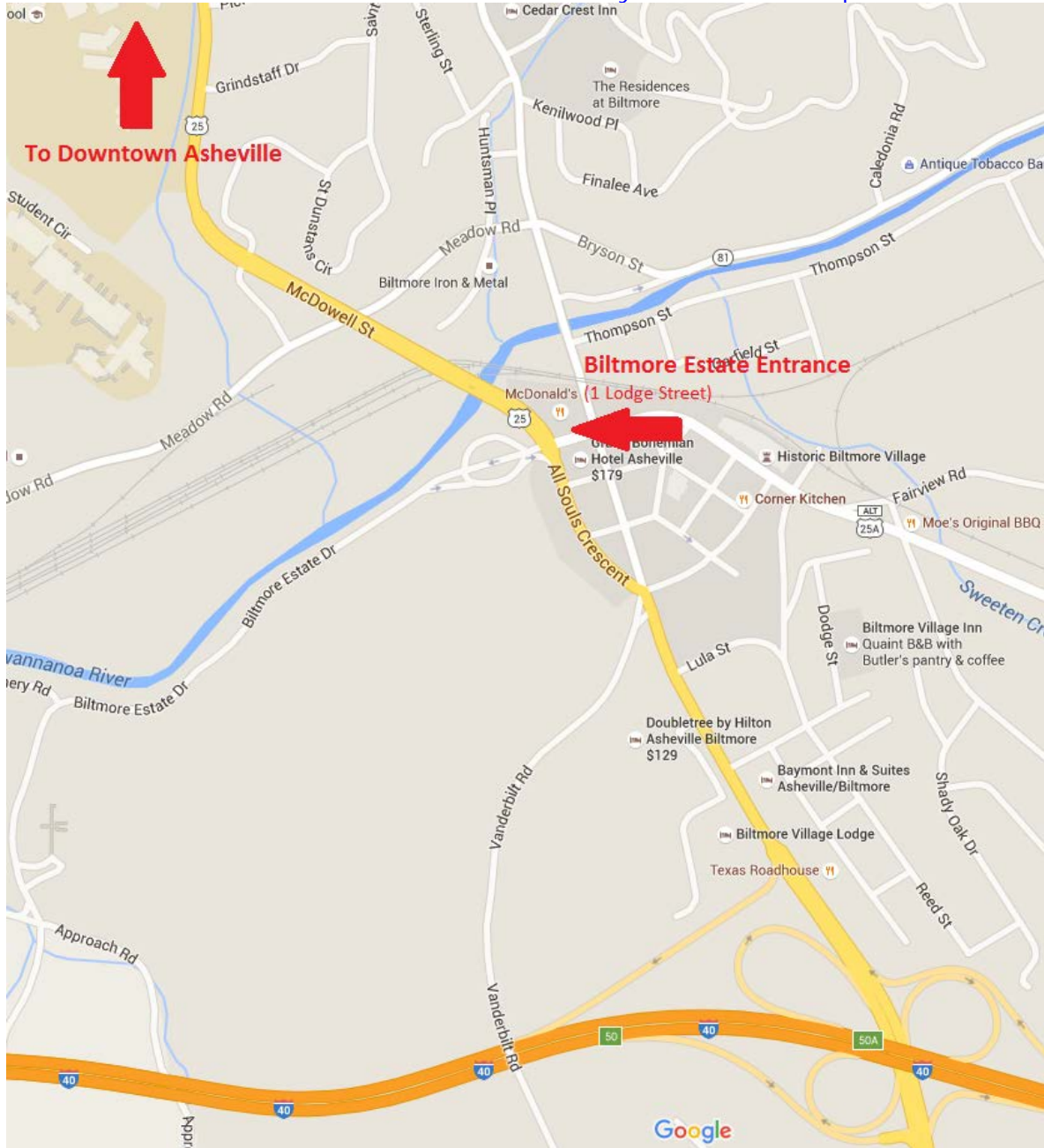

## Biltmore Estate Antler Hill Village (Tour) and The Inn on Biltmore Estate (Reception)



### Biltmore Estate Agriculture and Sustainability Tour—Tuesday 2 pm Optional Activity

Advance RSVP required for tour. **Arrive at main Estate entrance by 1:30 pm to reach Antler Hill Village by 1:45 pm. Tour departs promptly at 2 pm. Late arrivals cannot be accommodated.**

#### Important Tour and Estate Information

The optional Agriculture and Sustainability Tour starts from Antler Hill Village and runs from 2:00 pm – 4:00 pm. The tour will be conducted from two shuttle buses, with several stops along the way. This tour does NOT visit the Biltmore House. Those who have signed up to participate in the tour are entitled to tickets that grant admission to the Biltmore House and grounds for the full day. You may choose to explore the House (open 9 am – 5 pm) and grounds (open 9 am – dusk) before the tour or between the tour and the 5:30 pm reception at the Inn on Biltmore Estate (located near Antler Hill Village).

If you want to arrive early to visit the House and grounds prior to the tour, you will need to stop by the Group Sales Office (first building on the right before going through any entrance gates into the Estate) any time prior to 1:15 pm to pick up your pass. The Group Sales representative will have a list of confirmed LNC participants. Be advised that it takes about 30 minutes to drive between Antler Hill Village (tour start location) and the Biltmore House. There is also plenty to see around Antler Hill Village, including the Winery and Antler Hill Barn. Anyone arriving after 1:15 pm should proceed straight to Antler Hill Village.

Those arriving just for the Sustainability Tour do NOT need to stop at the Group Sales Office. They should follow instructions below to proceed directly to Antler Hill Village, where they will be given their Tour and Estate tickets.

Those arriving just for the reception do not need tickets and should follow reception directions below to proceed directly to the Inn on Biltmore Estate.

### Gate Entrance Information and Parking Details for Early Arrivals

1. Turn into the Estate from McDowell Street (heading south) or All Souls Crescent (heading north).
2. BEFORE the first set of gates, turn right to park at the Group Sales Office (first building on the right as soon as you turn into the Estate).
3. Enter the Group Sales Office and pick up your ticket for the Estate and grounds for the day.
4. Return to your car and proceed through the gates, showing your ticket as requested.
5. Explore the Estate on your own schedule but be sure to reach Antler Hill Village by 1:45 pm to board the shuttle buses for the Sustainability tour.
6. Free parking is available next to Antler Hill Village.
7. The group will meet at the Antler Hill Village roundabout, near the Creamery, to board the buses.

### Gate Entrance Information and Parking Details for Sustainability Tour

1. From the main entrance, proceed through each of the two entrance gates. You do NOT need to stop at the office to pick up a ticket.
2. Let the guards know you are with the Leadership North Carolina group and ask them to direct you to Antler Hill Village.
3. Allow 15 minutes to drive from the main entrance to Antler Hill Village.
4. Free parking is available next to Antler Hill Village.
5. The group will meet at the Antler Hill Village roundabout, near the Creamery, to board the shuttle buses for the tour.

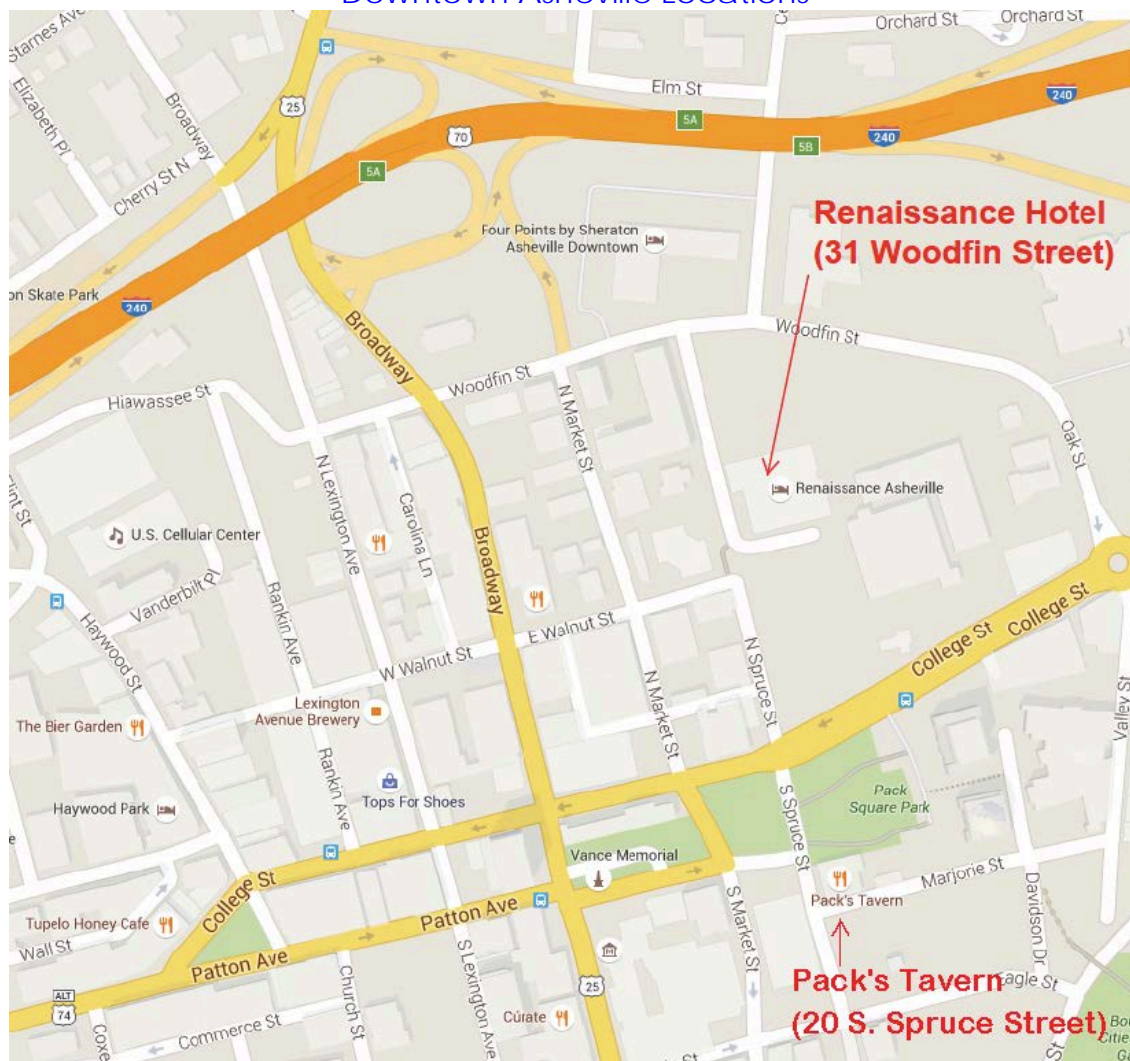
### Gate Entrance Information and Parking

## Parking

1. All visitors must register their vehicles in advance and print a parking permit to display during session through the following link: [UNC Asheville - Visitor Parking Permit](#). Select "Visitor Permits" and use the online registration portal. You will need the following to register your vehicle:
  - EFP Start Date: April 3, 2019
  - Reason for Visit: Leadership North Carolina Environment Session
  - Driver License State and Number
  - Vehicle Make, Model, and Year
  - Vehicle License Plate Number and State of Issuance
  - Vehicle Insurance Provider
2. Once you have registered your vehicle, you will be emailed a parking permit. Please display the permit on your vehicle's dashboard during Wednesday's session. Permits are NOT transferable between vehicles.
3. The best parking for Wednesday's session is available with the visitors parking permit in Lots 9 and 11 (see map). You must have a permit to park in all UNC Asheville visitor lots. Do NOT park in spots blocked by cones—these are reserved for session presenters.
4. Once the lower section of the Lot 9 deck fills up, additional parking is available across the street in Lot 11 (recommended) or in the upper deck of Lot 9. If you prefer to park in the upper section of Lot 9, you'll need to exit the lower level by turning left and left again to access the upper portion of the deck.
5. After parking, enter through the main doors of the arena and follow the hallway down the left side of the arena to the Mountain View Room.

### Parking Instructions and Walking Directions to Meeting Location

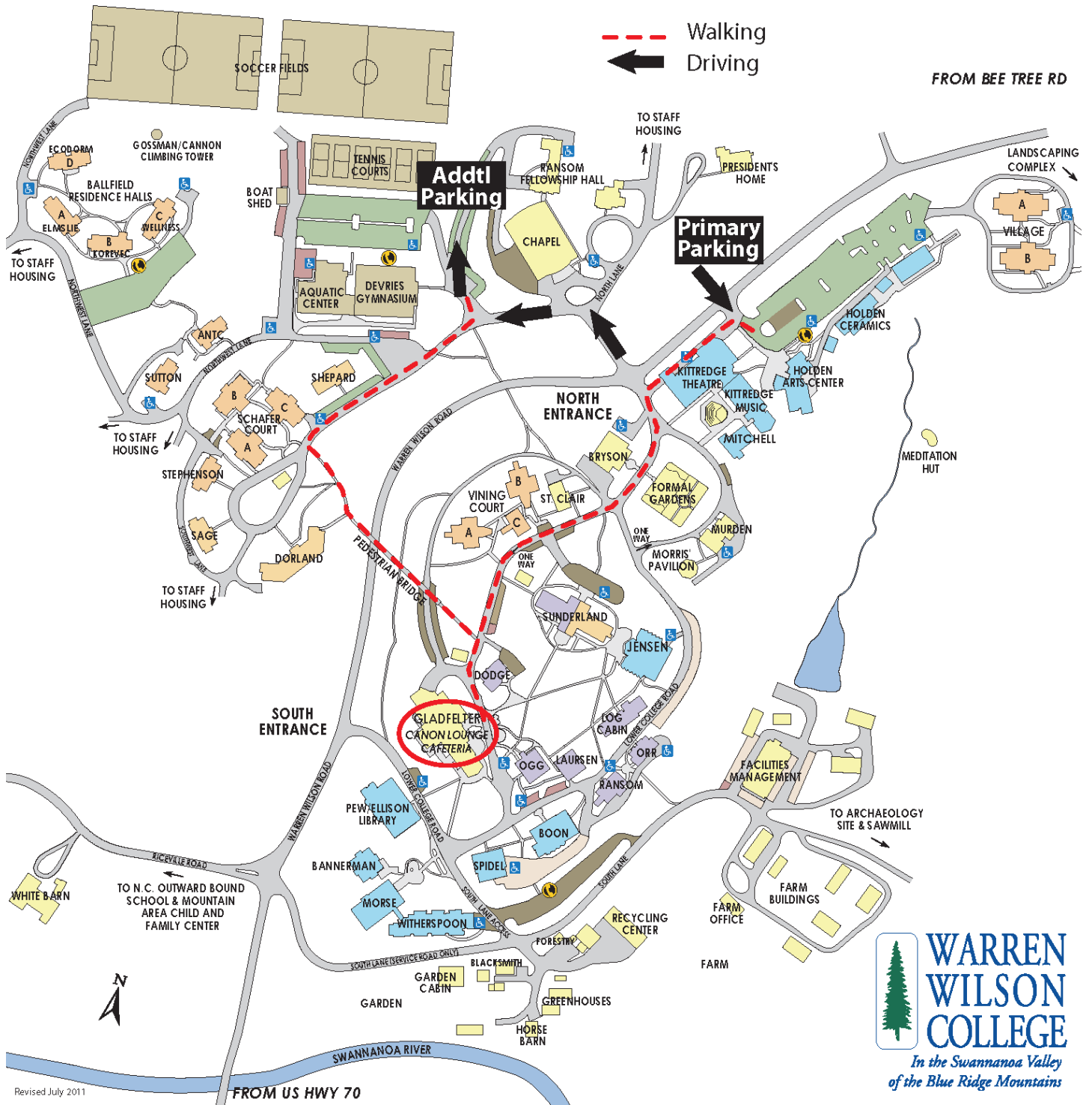
1. Pass the south and north entrances to campus.
2. Pass the Kittredge Theater on the right.
3. Take the next right to turn into the Kittredge Theater "Primary Parking" lot and park.
4. Display the attached parking pass on your dash.
5. If the Kittredge Theater lot is full, additional parking is available on the other side of Warren Wilson Road near the Chapel. Follow signs to "Additional Parking."
6. Follow the walking route from your parking location, both of which are marked with the dashed line on the map below, for **the 5-10 minute walk** to reach the Gladfelter Student Union.

### Footwear Reminder

Wear or bring along comfortable shoes. The Green Walkabout tour requires a good bit of walking and includes one set of steep steps (only used for going down, not up). If you need special accommodations, let Kelly know in advance.
